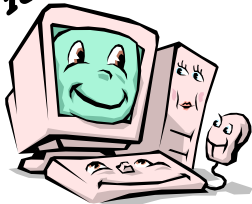

Computer Enrichment Program

Dear Parent,

Starting September 2nd we will be offering our school year program of exciting new computer classes on Friday mornings from 9:15 to 10:00. A second class will be added if needed.

These weekly classes provide a valuable way for young children ages three through five to expand and apply their computer knowledge. Each lesson starts by examining particular computer concepts, components and skills at an age appropriate level. The children then spend most of the class time on the computers using a variety of applications and educational children's programs to reinforce learning points covered earlier in class.

Instruction is at two levels. The younger children begin with the basics of computer literacy when they learn to manipulate the mouse, operate the keyboard, use menus, and access their favorite software. Imagination runs high with colorful, exploratory pre-reading software that develops motor skills and learning basics, such as memory, colors, numbers, shapes and letters. Older children concentrate more on how to make the computer work for them, using software which fosters creativity, pre-reading, reading, writing, categorization and quantitative skills.

The classes are given by certified teachers using Windows computers in small groups. Take-home handouts are distributed with each lesson, providing a good basis for discussing the class with your child. The cost is \$40 a month, reduced on a pro-rata basis for any month with less than four classes offered. Tuition is billed monthly through the mail.
